**Program Dates: October 10, 2017 to December 7, 2017**

Dear Families,

We are pleased to announce a number of exciting enrichment programs available to the students in Deerfield. Enclosed you will find general information, program descriptions, and registration materials for the **Deerfield Elementary School Fall Enrichment Series**.

**Workshop Dates:** Enrichment programs are offered in two sessions each year (fall & spring) and run for 8 weeks. The **fall session** will run eight weeks, from **Tuesday, October 10th through Thursday, December 7th**. Registration forms must be returned on or before Thursday, September 28<sup>th</sup>.

Programs do not meet on full In-Service Days, vacation weeks, or when school is cancelled. Please make all efforts to arrange pickup so your child is present for the entirety of each class. Children must be signed-out with an after-school staff member; enrichment instructors do not have sign-out sheets. Please call the program, 665-1408, or send a note if your child will not be attending.

**Cost:** Program rates are calculated to cover instructor fees, supplies, snack, and additional after-school staff necessary due to increased participant numbers before and after the enrichments. Fees are listed on the attached registration form. A check for the enrichment fee, made **payable to the "Town of Deerfield"**, is due with registration.

Deerfield After-School Program participants may participate in enrichments offered on their regularly scheduled days for lesser fee, applied to enrichment expenses. You will be contacted only if a desired workshop is full and placed on a wait list, or if low enrollment has resulted in a program cancellation.
